CONDITIONS

1. I give permission for my child / children attending Vacation Care on their booked days to participate in the activities stated on the Active OOSH Cameron Park Autumn 2021 Vacation Care program.
2. I understand that my child must wear sun safe clothing, enclosed shoes and be provided with recess, lunch and a drink bottle for all enrolled days.
3. I understand that if my child attends the service without a hat, Active OOSH Cameron Park will supply my child with a hat and \$10 will be added to my account.
4. I agree that my child / children will have sunscreen applied prior to arriving at the service as well as authorising permission for sunscreen application every hour throughout the day.
5. I agree to the services 24-hour booking cancellation policy.
6. I give permission for my child to be photographed by the educators at the service and be displayed on the Active OOSH website and Facebook page.
7. I understand that incursion and service activities are held at 107 Northlakes Drive, Cameron Park, NSW, 2285.

SERVICE AND INCURSION DETAILS:

During the Autumn 2021 Vacation Care period, Active OOSH Cameron Park estimates that each day the service will have between 100 and 145 children booked into the service (Maximum 145). All other family bookings will be placed on the service waiting list. The service follows a 1 educator to 15 children ratio (1:15) on a daily basis.

COVID-19 SAFETY INFORMATION:

Parents / carers are to wait at the service iPad to collect their children. Educators will use walkie talkies to instruct children to collect their bags and meet their parents / carers at the meeting point. The service has hand sanitiser available to all parents / carers on arrival at the service. Parents / carers must use this prior to using the service iPad to sign their children in or out of the service. On arrival to the service all children will thoroughly wash their hands. At each roll call point throughout the day and before and after consuming food, children will be instructed to wash their hands. Where possible all children and educators will maintain social distancing.

MEDICAL ADMINISTRATION:

An educator will always be present at the service that holds first aid training and an accredited certificate. As the authorised person, I understand that educators will provide medical care as required including calling an ambulance if required. I understand that if my child requires medication to be administered at the service that **I will provide the service with the medication in a webster pack outlining the child's name, date of birth, dosage amount, time of medication and method of medication.**
